On April 8, 2026, Jacob Dominguez of Uvalde County pled guilty to the offense of possession of a controlled substance, penalty group 1, four to 200 grams, a second-degree felony. This case stems from an investigation by the city of Uvalde Police Department when they responded to a domestic disturbance call at the defendant's girlfriend's home on February 20, 2024. The defendant was found to be in possession of 25.19 grams of methamphetamine. The defendant accepted a plea offer agreement in lieu of proceeding to trial on this charge and other felony charges pending against the defendants. The defendant accepted a plea agreement of twenty years confinement in the Texas Department Criminal Justice, ("TDCJ").

District Attorney, Christina Mitchell, former assistant district attorney E. Benavides, and Investigator, A. Maldonado, prosecuted this case on behalf of the state of Texas.
